



## Reflection

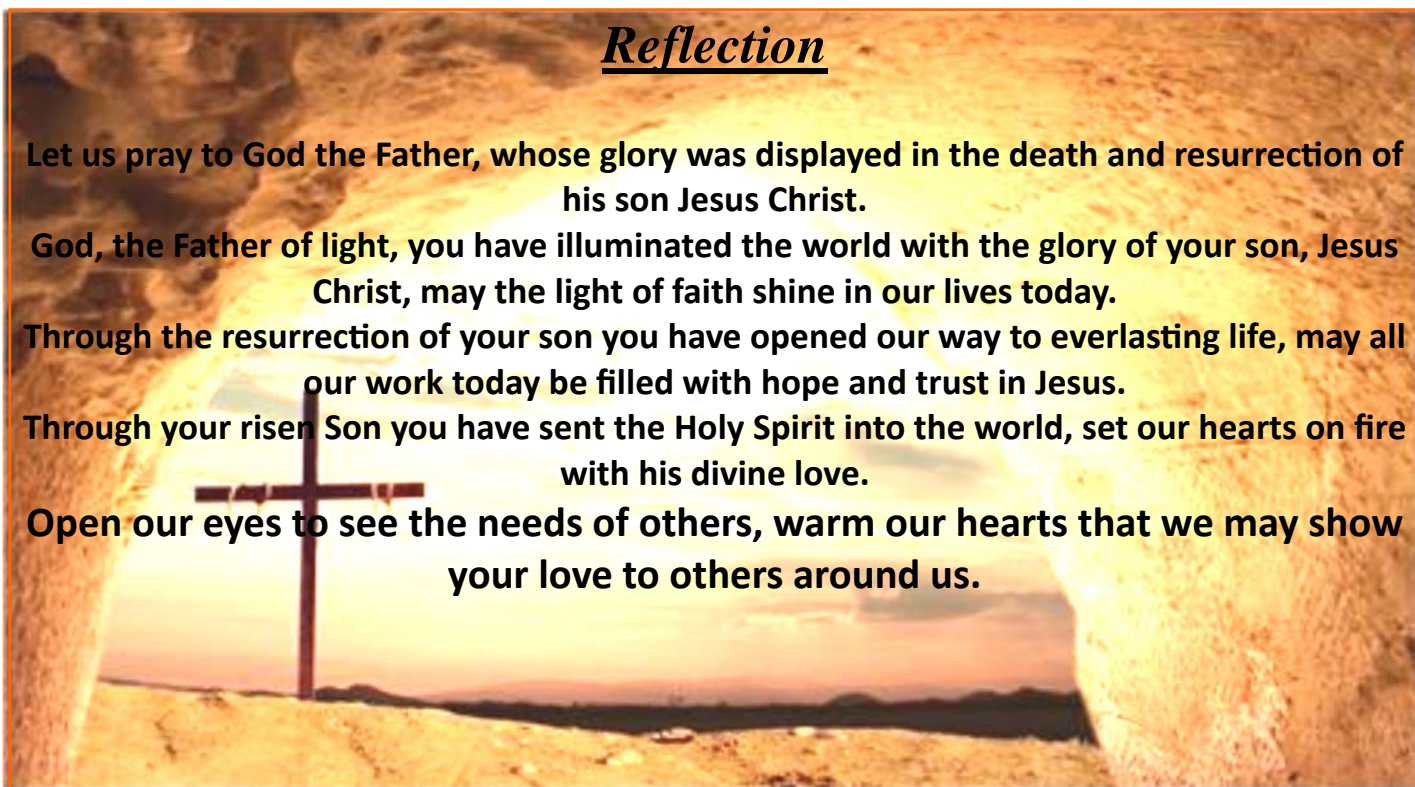
Let us pray to God the Father, whose glory was displayed in the death and resurrection of his son Jesus Christ.

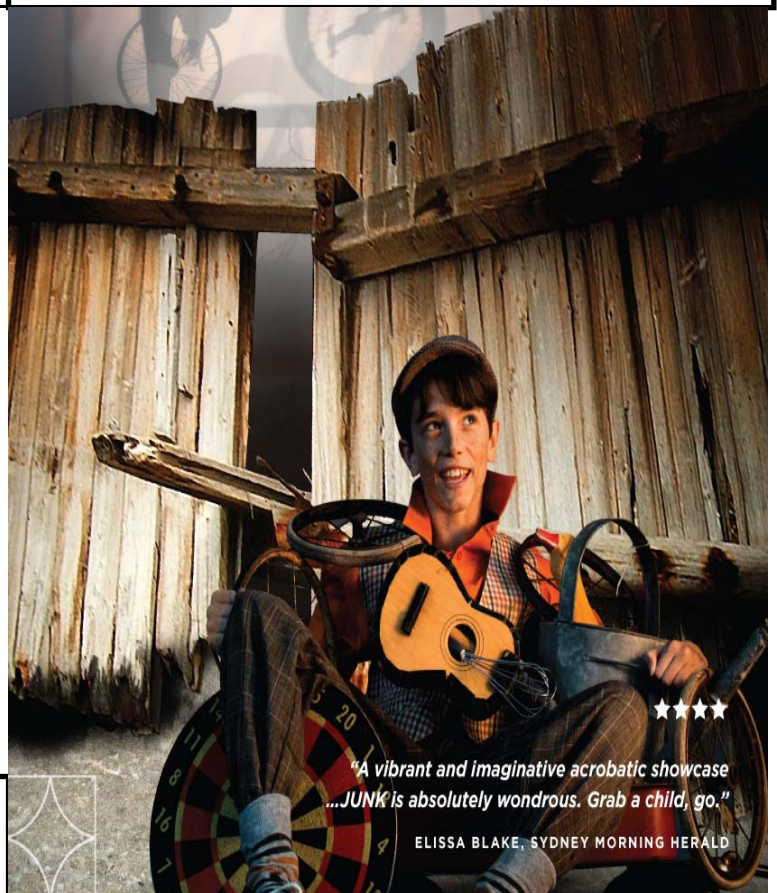
