Nano Nagle, an Irish Catholic woman was born 300 years ago in 1718. Nano established the Presentation Sisters order. In 1874, five Presentation Sisters arrived in Wagga Wagga and the first Catholic primary school in the Diocese of Wagga was established in a stable in the grounds of St Joseph's. Initially there were 130 students who were taught in the stable.
