ST JOSEPH'S ATHLETICS CARNIVAL 2018

Our Athletics Carnival will be held on Friday 9th March at Jubilee Park. All students are expected to participate in the carnival. Transport will be by Allen's Buses. Carnival costs are included in the school fees.

Children are allowed to wear either suitable clothing in the colour of their house or their school sports uniform. Please ensure that they apply sunscreen before and during the carnival, and that they have plenty to eat and drink

PLEASE NOTE THAT THERE WILL BE NO CANTEEN AVAILABLE AT THE CARNIVAL THIS YEAR.

We have booked the Scribbles coffee van to visit Jubilee park on the morning of the carnival.

Children will not be permitted to run in bare feet. Spiked shoes are to be carried over to the marshalling area and only put on just before the race commences.

Primary students will be participating in the 100m, relay, discus, long jump and shot put events. The 200m and 800m races are optional. High jump trials will be conducted at school prior to the carnival to ascertain the competitors for this event.

The buses will leave the school at 9:05 a.m. All children will come to school and then travel to Jubilee Park on the bus. Primary school children may go home with their parents **AFTER** the carnival, once all presentations have concluded, and **ONLY AFTER** advising their class teacher so as to be marked off the roll. A bus will return with the remaining children to school in time to catch afternoon buses or to be picked up by parents.

Kindergarten, Year 1 and Year 2 children will be participating in their age race followed by a variety of activities. The K-2 carnival will finish at approximately 1:00 p.m. If parents wish to keep or take home their infant child they can do so after advising their class teacher, so as to be marked off the roll. A bus will return to school at 1 p.m. with the remaining Kindergarten, Year 1 and Year 2 children and their teachers.

If you can help on the day, please see Mr Lawler who will be running the carnival this year, and he will advise you where you are needed.
